Leaving a garage door open gives the opportunity to a would be robber to gain access to your personal belongings being stored as well as access to the interior of your house without being seen if they enter and close the garage door. There are certainly some easy things you can do to minimize the risk of a burglary.

- Have your neighbor pick up your mail and newspapers
- Notify your local security co. that you will be away
- Leave lights on automatic timers to give the appearance someone is home
- Let your neighbors know when you are leaving and plan to return and don't place the fact that you are gone on your telephone answering machine
- Keep vehicles locked & your garage remote secure so that a robber can not steal it and use it at a later time to gain entry into your house

The best defense is communication. Report all suspicious activity.
