TRICK-OR-TREAT!

Boo! The sounds of little feet will soon be heard scampering door to door, "trick-or-treat!" Halloween is an exciting night of the year and particularly special for young children. It is also a time to be extra vigilant for potential safety hazards.

Executive Security Agency wants everyone to have a happy, fun and safe Halloween by following these safety tips:

HOMEOWNERS

- Turn on your porch light so children know it is appropriate to visit your home.
• If you are placing a Jack-O-Lantern on your porch, place a glow stick inside instead of a candle.
• Hand out only commercially wrapped candy.
• Never invite children into your house.
• Keep pets away from children.
• Maintain clear walkways free from obstruction.
• Immediately notify Security of any suspicious activity.

MOTORISTS

- Drive slowly and cautiously.
• Look for children walking on the street, running, and darting in between parked vehicles.
• Be careful when entering & exiting driveways and play your music at a reasonable volume so you can hear children crossing your path.
• Never drink and drive.

PARENTS

- Always escort your children and carry a flashlight.
• Always be familiar with the neighborhood where your children will be trick-or-treating.
• Always know who is trick-or-treating with your children and instruct them to walk on sidewalks & not in the middle of the street.
• Inspect all treats before allowing children to eat them.

TRICK-OR-TREATERS

- Obey all signals and traffic lights.
